CWCT COOKIE EXCHANGE

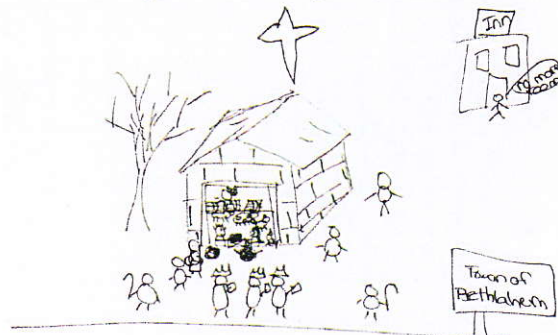
December 13, 2015
